A Collaboration that Works.....

In 2002 Family Service was recognized by the United Way in Albany as a “collaboration that works”. The program was the subject of an Intensive assessment by Helen Castle of HSC Consulting, LLC, reflecting a positive impact on the individuals served.

Family Service officials said the study shows the impact of specialized mental health services offered with immediate accessibility is far reaching. The reduction of stress in the discreet environment of any campus delivers a direct, profound and broad based impact on the entire school population, in addition to addressing the specific needs of clients and their families, it says in the study. This results in stronger, healthier and safer communities, in which families can live and grow.

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
